

York Fire Department is accepting application for the position of Fire Captain. We currently have one opening and this list may be active for up to two years. The application period is open until July 1, 2019 at 4:00 pm. Applications and resumes received after this date and time will not be considered.

Current salary range \$45992.00 to \$64821.00 per year, with a comprehensive benefit package.

The York Fire Department is a combination career and volunteer fire and rescue department. We provide advanced life support ambulance service to most of York County and fire suppression services to the City of York and the York Rural Fire District encompassing 93 square miles. Typically, the York Fire Department responds to about 1250 calls for service each year.

There is a total of 14 career members: Fire Chief, Assistant Chief, 3 Captains and 6 Firefighter/Paramedics, 1 Firefighter/ EMTI-95, and 3 Firefighter/EMT's. The career staff are scheduled on duty for 24 hours and off 48 hours.

There are also about 25 volunteer firefighters in the department.

The Fire Captain is the shift supervisor. This is a highly skilled firefighting, emergency medical services, rescue, and fire prevention position. Extinguish and prevent fires to protect life and property; maintains fire station equipment, apparatus, quarters, and operating equipment; provide public education; and perform prevention duties. Plan, schedule, supervise, and manage work assignments. Provides firefighting and EMS training to both career and volunteer members. Work is performed in accordance with general supervision and written procedures, under the command of a senior officer.

Experience Required:

Five (5) years of fulltime, or Ten (10) years of volunteer firefighter and EMS experience or a combination thereof, with the York Fire Department or a comparable or larger department required. (Breaks in service of no more than ninety (90) days shall be considered de minimums and shall not be considered in calculating the consecutive years.)

Required qualifications:

High school diploma or equivalent required.

No felony convictions or serious misdemeanor.

Shall be able to read and write the English language.

Must possess a valid driver's license and maintain an insurable driving record.

Current Emergency Medical Technician License required. Current Paramedic License preferred.

Testing will consist of 2 written tests, an assessment center, and a structured interview. The written tests will be and assessment center are being planned for the week of July 22, and the actual dates will be emailed to the qualified applicants.

There will be two written tests. The first will be a 100-question test will measure your knowledge of tactics, company officer principles and practices, and safety. The second test will be 50-question test cover critical incident/human relations skills. They are not referenced to any published book.
