Meter pit usage

**Minimum size 48", manhole size 24" minimum
Precast concrete or as approved by the Water Superintendent
Only CPS fittings are allowed
Stainless steel with stiffener fitting and pack joint fitting are to be used**

It was decided to allow meter pits outside the city limits only. They are to follow the above guidelines.

Plastic service lines

**Pro – cost
Con – Hard to locate if tracer wire gets damaged
Con – DIY plumbers**

It was decided to stay with the current plumbing code that requires a copper service line.

Lawn backflow preventers

**Remind all contractors that new backflow preventers require testing at time of installation.
All lawn sprinkler installers must register as contractors.
All lawn sprinkler installs will need a building permit.
Licensed plumbers are to install the backflow devices.
Licensed plumbers, Grade VI water contractors and operators can test, repair and install backflow devices.
Lawn backflow devices should be a minimum 18" above the highest sprinkler head.**
