Bobbi Pettit with Five Rule Rural Planning presented to the Planning Commission the De-Blight Study; Proposed De-Designation of Portions of Redevelopment Areas 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6 and 7 for the City of York. She stated that as a city of the first class, only 35% is allowed to be blight and substandard. With the proposed blight/substandard and redevelopment plan, parts of the city that no longer need to be developed can be taken out of the blight/substandard classification. Most of the proposed properties are either developed or owned by non-taxable entities. Bobbi then answered questions of the planning commission.
