## RECOMMEND APPROVAL OF APPLICATION

The Chairman announced that this was the time and place set for the continuation of a public hearing on an application filed by Dylan McGowan for a special use permit to operate a commercial storage facility in the A-L Agricultural District on Irregular Tract 30, Section 2, Township 20 North, Range 3 West of the 6<sup>th</sup> P.M. Mr. McGowan presented the Commission site plan showing the location of proposed buildings, elevations, screening and drive way location. The Mayor advised that the property will drain to the southeast corner and then through a culvert—that by using rock on the premises, drainage will be greatly reduced. It was noted that outside storage will be between the buildings and thus will be screened by the buildings. Mr. McGowan stated that he will be installing the screening in phases with phase one being around the first building to be constructed. The Mayor noted that signs will be placed on the buildings – that no pole signs will be allowed.

Following discussion, Skaden moved and Heskett seconded to recommend approval to the council with the stipulation that outside storage be located between the buildings.
