<u>Accession Transition Policy</u> - passed September 14, 2021 -- all accessions must be approved by a vote of the museum board.

Process: [Shared by email]

- 1. Accession requests may be brought to a scheduled advisory board meeting for approval. At least 4 members must be present for a vote. The decision will be made by a majority of those board members present.
- 2. When accession decisions need to be made sooner than the next advisory board meeting, the accession proposal can be distributed via email to all advisory board members with permission from the Chair of the advisory board. The Chair will send the request to all members. At least four members must vote via email to approve the accession.
